## **Statement of Faith**

### **1. The Scriptures Inspired**

The Scriptures, both the Old and New Testaments, are verbally inspired of God and are the revelation of God to man, the infallible, authoritative rule of faith and conduct.

### **2. The Only True God**

The only one true God has revealed Himself as the eternally self-existent "I AM," the Creator of heaven and earth and the Redeemer of mankind. He has further revealed Himself as embodying the principles of relationship and association as Father, Son and Holy Spirit.

### **7. The Salvation of Man**

Salvation is received through repentance toward God and faith toward the Lord Jesus Christ. By the washing of regeneration and renewing of the Holy Spirit, being justified by grace through faith, man becomes an heir of God, according to the hope of eternal life.

### **8. Baptism in Water**

Baptism by immersion is commanded by the Scriptures. All who repent and believe on Christ as Savior and Lord are to be baptized. Thus they declare to the world that they have died with Christ and that they also have been raised with Him to walk in newness of life.

### **9. The Baptism in the Holy Spirit**

All believers are entitled to and should ardently expect and earnestly seek the promise of the Father, the baptism in the Holy Spirit and fire, according to the command of our Lord Jesus Christ. Luke 3:16 Speaking in tongues is a sign of the baptism of the Holy Spirit. Luke 24:49; Acts 1:4; Acts 1:8; 1 Corinthians 12:1-31

### **10. Holy Communion**

The Lord's Supper, bread and the fruit of the vine. This is expressing our sharing the divine nature of our Lord Jesus Christ 2 Peter 1:4, a memorial of his suffering and death 1 Corinthians 11:26. Stand before the Lord and proclaim His death, forgiveness of sins, and resurrection life. Present yourselves as alive from the dead to God the Father. Romans 6:13
